Dick:

Good morning, Tom, Sam, and Jetta (the dog).

Voices;

Good morning.

Dick:

This is Commander Francis Richard Scobee. And good morning to those of you who are going to be viewing this tape. As I understand it, the schoolteacher of us requested a special showing, and she would like this directed to several people, including, I understand, the fine Senator from Rhode Island and his helpmate and administrator. We greet you as well and welcome you into our realm of experience.

Well now, (sighs) I understand there's a holiday going on around here called Christmas. Well, it's going to be a challenging season, I think, for us, simply because... We've done pretty well up until now, and we're going to perhaps find ourselves having to live now while we've been learning. I think you can understand that — dealing with our family and our friends. So we're gearing up for the experiences.

Well, anyway, I understand that I look rather pretty this morning, and you'll have to excuse me if I make comments about my beautiful freckle face and my red lips (laughs). I haven't thought much about it recently until I was standing up with Jeanne as she was primping for the occasion so that she would come across on the tape as looking appropriate; and I got struck by how funny it really was that she primps in order to look nice for other people, and yet, she's not even her! (laughs)

I come in and I could give a flying finger if I had on my lipstick and my hair curled! (laughs) But that's the irony of our lives, I think, since the Challenger exploded — it's really kind of funny. Fortunately for me, I'm a lot more used to this than I was ten months ago. But that's neither here or there — we've learned a lot. Well, since I'm in a role of leadership in terms of being the commander, my crew allows me to come in first and set the pace, I guess you might say. As I was entering into Jeanne's body I was thinking of how different it is for me versus the first few nights that I found my way into her consciousness.

I didn't understand what the hell was going on and how I could suddenly have red lips and curled hair (and big boobs)! But through the months it has become obvious to all of us how important our mission really is. And I understand that among the people who do know about this communication there are some questions about how it should be handled and where it should go. And all I can say to all of you is that we're learning the ropes, maybe even a little more slowly than you people are, because we're having to become adept at this whole routine.

Whereas, from what I understand, most all of you viewing this tape have had a lot of other experiences with this type of phenomenon. Initially, we wanted so very much to communicate with our families. But we've found through the months the frustration of it,

because they're having to deal with their trauma and realizing that we can't ask them to deal with too much.

First of all, the trauma of our deaths. Second of all, the working back into society as a single partner, or whatever, and for our children to become accustomed to not having both parents available all the time. And then dealing with all the publicity that our deaths brought forth. So, initially, we were really pressuring them to experience us, and then we finally realized the hard way that it was not, indeed, a very good idea.

So now we've been working on other levels and in other ways. We haven't given up the idea of communication, but we realize that our approach has to be somewhat different. And again we say that we don't really know exactly what that should be, except that we're not going to expect too much too quickly. And we know that if we do try to expect too much too quickly, we'll probably damn ourselves into oblivion in terms of having our families support this phenomenon.

And I'm speaking now for the whole crew — we've been working a couple of weeks on this presentation which may seem simple to you but really takes a lot of work on our part — takes a lot of work with Jeanne. Certainly, doing this in the morning is much easier for all of us, because the energies for the medium are much more rested and quick.

But the points that I would like to make clear for myself and for the crew today are these: there's a mission and we've accepted our part of it, and that is to work our damndest to know ourselves, know what we are, where we are, where we've come from, what it is that we have chosen to do. And all of us are totally dedicated to staying together as a group for some time in order to bring about as much mass communication as possible.

We have not gone "psychic hopping"; we have chosen a few who have been very responsive to us and who are dedicated to the same type of spiritual communications as we are. They are not Hollywood freaks or money seekers or fame and fortune seekers. These are people who are dedicated and committed to God. People who have experienced the channeling that Jeanne and Tom and Sam have done in a live situation and feel the presence.

And there's no question — we don't have to force words or ideals on anybody. The presence is there. And although we can't be everywhere we can begin by beginning somewhere and going from there. In this day of modern communication I guess we're blessed with the VCR — maybe that was created solely for this purpose — not in terms of just the seven of us but in terms of being able to contact billions of people without commercial interruptions so the quality of the program can be spiritually based and effective and not run by the almighty dollar or someone's greed.

Certainly it was our own greed that seemed to manifest us into the space program. And I know that you political people out there are very aware of the motivations of anyone

who gets into the program, that we are hungry for recognition, we are hungry for the ultimate thrill and will do just about anything to get there.

Certainly we are billed as outstanding and forthright citizens because the whole space program wants that image. But you and I know that that is not always the case. It's a political system, and it's what we have; and I have not come in here to rant and rave but only to state some facts — the truth that I'm sure you all are well aware of.

We don't want people to suffer, and it seems to me that people really suffer when they think there's nothing more to life than to die. There's a bumper sticker "Life is a bitch and then it's over." That's disgusting. Life is continual and everlasting, and we found that out the hard way. But seeking to be in the space program was our little game we played. Dying was our purpose, our destiny, our mission. And the hard fact for us to swallow for these many months was that we really chose this experience.

Sure there's all this karmic stuff — some of us got into it more than others. But whether or not we have anything to repay, we certainly have something to give. I don't expect to be a prophet in my own hometown. I don't expect my wife and children to think that Daddy is really talking through this medium.

But I do know people who are less prejudiced, who have known me not as a family member or father or husband, but as a friend or acquaintance, who knew me enough that they are not attached to me but know my mannerisms and my ideals. I've changed an awful lot, but I think there's enough of me left that people would know. I've gotten to be a lot more of a talker on this side. That hasn't always been easy, but I do talk about things that are important to me.

I do speak strongly about things that are so much a part of me that it just spills over. And this is a part of me — this is all of me now. The one thing that we had to overcome was fear. The fear of not having a body anymore. The fear of not being able to touch our loved ones anymore. The fear of not being heard. Those are powerful fears. Let me tell you brothers and sister, it's powerful.

But if we can overcome, then so can you folks. If you can put aside your fear and realize that God is running this goddamn show, then you'll do what you need to do, and you'll go where you need to go, and you'll be directed to where you need to be directed to in order to get this type of phenomenon out and (be) respectable. (long pause)

God has given me the greatest gift — and that's life. Because I'm just beginning to live. And that would hurt a lot of people I lived with when I was in a physical body, but it's true. And it has nothing to do with them; it has everything to do with me. Oh sure, I lived life; I enjoyed the finer things in life; I struggled long enough as a student with a young family; I was hungry enough times that when I finally had enough money in my pocket I enjoyed it. There was always something gnawing in my guts, and I was always reaching out for something else better, stronger, and more fulfilling. Flying was a part of it, but it certainly wasn't all of it.

But being in space where I found my God — come back upon a wonderful glow, realizing how significant God really is. Couldn't wait to get back up. Now I know why! If there is anything in your lives that you can be touched by, allow yourselves to be touched by the freedom of living.

And you say, "Well that's all well and good for you, Dick. You don't have a body anymore — you can do whatever you damn well please!" Bullshit! There's rules and regulations and structures and philosophies and communities over here just as real. And we have just as many fears on this side as you do in the physical body. (softly)

But there's one difference. Without the density of the physical world, everything is much more interesting. And without the density of the concept of linear time you can get from one place to the other real quickly! ...That difference makes all the difference in how we use our time and how we use our moments and how we express ourselves and deal and relate to each other.

I've seen a lot of people here crash into walls — the walls of thought and consciousness, because they couldn't handle the freedom. And they wanted to be tied down and they wanted the pain and they wanted to suffer! And I've seen other people make transitions and within a week's time be away far ahead of where I am, because the freedom was so wonderful... I think the earth is the place where we learn how to "do it." If we can remember how to "do it"...

Well, there's a couple of other folks that want to speak. I've shared my philosophy. I've given a lot of evidential information — talked about my wife, my kids, my relationships with them. I'm getting to the point where I don't really want to prove myself much more — I've done that for almost a year now. It's all on tape. I feel a year of proving myself in terms of who and what I am is appropriate. And now I want to exercise the freedom. And that freedom is to speak of things other than the kind of food I ate when I was poor, what kind of car I drove, my relationship with my family.

Now I want to be able to offer something a lot more profound, and to share with a lot of people what it's been like. I want to share with a lot of people what they can look forward to now, here. I want to share with a lot of people what they can do to really truthfully bring peace on earth.

But if I have to, I'll dig back into the memory banks; I'll go back in my thought processes to find out some more information. If I have to, I'll dig up more stuff that proves who I am. But as I said a long time ago ... who I am. 'Cause all I have to do is sit across from you and deal through Jeanne and know what you guys are all about. (pause)

Christa:

Hi, this is Christa McAuliffe. Boy, he was really beautiful, really something! He is very special to us. Here I am in front of a television camera – I'll pretend that is what it is. Tom, you don't look like Mike Gumbel and Sam, you don't look anything like Jane Pauley.

Christa:

That would make me feel worse! (laughs) Actually, I guess I'm showing my prejudice. I really liked being on the Today Show. I was on a whole bunch of them. I don't know, I guess I was really... (some unintelligible conversation) Anyway, here I am in all my glory. I do care about Jeanne's primping - although she has to curl her hair and I have to straighten mine and I didn't ever put on as much makeup as she does, but I wish I had after I looked at some of the pictures that they had of me.

Yes, this is really Christa. Yes, I have been working with these lovely wonderful people for almost a year, which seems hard to believe. I think that our commander spoke very eloquently of our needs and really spoke very much for all of us in terms of what's important to us. What he forgot to mention, though - he had to leave something for someone to say - is how much a part of this everyone can be. After all the fear is gone and an acceptance of this being reality comes forth.

You know, as a teacher, there's so much more I wanted to teach. Wasn't that the ultimate experience of being up in space? Why, I should be able to give everybody something they hadn't had before. Jeanne had been going back over a couple of things that people quoted about me when I talked about "coming back from the great beyond" and teaching about what I had learned and how profound those statements were. It still kind of chokes me up inside to realize that I knew very well that something very great was going to happen.

But again, it was all interpretation - I didn't know what it was or how it was going to be. I just thought that it would be the obvious - that I'd go up into space and have my little couple of days up there and then come back and then be forgotten. But, you know, if I had come home - I've thought about that a lot recently - if I had done what I was supposed to do as far as just flying up there and doing my schoolwork and then coming back.

What would it have been like for me to come back? Would I ever really ever have been able to stand in the classroom again and be content? Or would I have been like the kids across the ocean after they fought in World War I and you couldn't get them back to farm the fields? That's a question I won't be able to answer. Really, I can only speculate. And as much as I miss my family and as much as I miss my friends, I can honestly say that I would miss this much more.

Sam and Jeanne watched an episode of "St. Elsewhere" last week in which Holly Mendal was shot and had this out-of-body experience. And they said, "You can stay if you want to," and he said, "Oh I really want to stay." And then they zapped him I don't

know how many times and he came back. Sam said that he watched it last night and the guy was so depressed because he had to come back!

I think that I can honestly say for myself now, although this might hurt my family - sorry. No, I'm not sorry; it's just the truth! I think I can honestly say that it would be very hard for me, because now that I've seen all the possibilities and the potential, and there's this wonderful communication going on. I'd miss a lot more opportunities in a physical body, and it would probably take me a lot longer to get where I am now, physically, than where I am without the body. And I feel like Dick also does.

This is my destiny and this is where I'm going. Jeanne and I are wonderful friends. I can't speak enough of her, because she and I share the same kind of soul, I guess-- that's what they say. We're kind of part of each other. You would have to be there to know, to experience it. Take my word for it - it's so real.

The whole point of it is that we all have parts of ourselves wandering around the globe. And we have kind of fragmented ourselves in different parts and pieces just so we can spread the light and some understanding. Unfortunately, a lot of pieces and parts don't seem to have the same kind of illumination or memory that they did when they were more together and more a part of the total. Yet we're all part of the total, it's just a matter of memory, I guess. I'm still learning.

My mother and father did a lot of good for me. Since I chose to be the first-born, I was very strong-willed, very independent. I got what I wanted when I wanted it. They didn't often understand me all the time. I was a pretty regular person, but I was very definite about what was right, what was wrong. I did what I wanted when I wanted. The space program was a part of that personality. I wanted it! I certainly didn't think it was going to happen to me, but I wanted it. I had dreams about it at night - Stephen knows that.

Stephen knows a lot about the things that went on with me. And Stephen, if you ever listen to this tape - I don't know if you will - I still love you. That may seem a little absurd to you. But it seems a little absurd to me that I come hanging around you and you don't acknowledge me. So if you think this is absurd, think about it from my point of view - how I feel trying to communicate with you, and you won't have anything to do with me! Think about yourself being in my position and how you'd feel, and then don't be so quick to judge another on that experience.

I want to say a few things to Senator Pell and his dear wonderful friend, Scott. I've been around you recently; I've heard you talking, sharing ideas - what you should do, what you shouldn't do, worried about the political arena, worried about your standing in the community. I know I'm a novice at this, but I'd like to share some ideas if I can.

I found out very quickly that the more I let God in my life as director, the more beautiful it became. And the more I resisted it, the less I had. You and the people you know in Washington have a great responsibility. You feel the weight of that responsibility, I know. However, it's not your responsibility alone. You come into this lifetime with many,

many other people, all doing their part to bring about enlightenment, freedom, love, understanding and peace. If you allow yourselves to be bound by fear of what others will think, you'll never get anything done.

I'm a teacher - very political. I have classrooms of children every day, and I'm not after their love and affection. If I did, they would never come back! I taught them. I still teach them. I still walk in my classrooms, I still walk down the hall of the high school, I walk the streets of my home. But I don't walk as a ghost or as a mourner; I walk with love and peace and the thought that someday something will trigger each and every person to know the continuity of life and the responsibility that they must have... to take care of itself.

When you do what you're supposed to do, no matter what it seems like, it works out right. It may not be as you planned, but if you deny your destiny it gets worse. I guess there were several times in my life I could have copped out. I guess when I was an infant and was so deathly sick, that was a part of me saying, "Hey man, I don't want this, I wanna go home!" And I came back--and I'm glad I did.

Just because we're politicians or teachers or whatever, doesn't mean that we don't have a destiny to fill. Just think of the way it was when all those wonderful gifted people came over to America and fought against the British. Just think of what it was like for the Patrick Henrys, the Benjamin Franklins, John Adams, Thomas Jefferson. What was it like for them to be radical, different? But look what they did! Look what they did!

And it's time for America to go through another surge again. That's why it's all happening here. And what we would really like to get across is for people to feel their destiny of their being here. Certainly we could be in Russia. Certainly we could be impoverished in the South African area. But that's not what we've chosen to do. We've chosen to bring in a new freedom.

Now we can accept it or throw it out the window. The Bible promises us, that as we sow we shall reap, as we give so we shall receive. If we truly want to receive - riches, consciousness, love, friendship - that's what we have to give. And if we don't give it, then we really don't want it. We have to make our decision, what's most important to us.

Standing with courage and love makes for a lot of people an attractive package. Standing with arrogance - I mean I've seen lots of politicians who feel they're so right they can stand with an arrogant nature. That's not all I'm talking about. It's a deep compassion like Gandhi and Martin Luther King. We've walked and talked with those people over here, and I've no time today to explain what it's been like for us. But it's been absolutely wonderful! If we can carry a part of their energies and their self-direction and dedication and bring it through mediums as we communicate, then we've done our job.

And like Dick said, I've given a lot of evidential information in the last ten-eleven months, and I'll be glad to give more. But now I'm hungry to be in contact with my friends who

won't rebuff me as easily as perhaps my family, and particularly my husband. Because my friends and I talked about things that my family and I did not talk about. If I could just sit across from one or two of them, and if they could understand what it's like to communicate with one, and if they could feel that it's really me. That seems to be the next year... that seems to be the next year.

Tom and Sam, they never even watch television about me, but they probably know more about me now than a lot of people do. I'm really fond of these two fellows. They don't realize how important they are. They really don't, and I want to give them credit. But to whomever is viewing this, I also want to wish you a Merry Christmas and a wonderful season, a wonderful re-birthing. And when you look up into the skies at night (if you're fortunate enough to live where you can see them), look at the stars, and imagine, if you will, each one of those stars being a part... sparkling, shining.
(Whispering) Thank you.

Mike:

(loudly) Well, hi! Ha, ha, ha! I know I can't move very far, but, damn it, take the chair out from under me 'cause I gotta stand up. You know me.

Sam:

I can move that microphone if you like.

Mike:

I'm fine. I'll stand right here. Glue me to the seat, move the camera. Hello, how are you. She should put a jacket on — no tie, thank God! She's got the pants on — let's get the pants here. Tell Mike to pull up his pants. Oh, I love that feeling. You don't got it yet? Well I'll pull 'em up again if you need me to. I'll just pose like Washington going over the Delaware or... X-rated video. That would be fun! Buttoning a woman's blouse is buttoning the wrong way — I don't know how to do that! How am I doin'?

Mike:

Oh, goddamn, it's wonderful! Now if I can just remember to keep my feet glued to the floor, everything will be fine. Hello out there in video land! (chuckles) I do tend to ham up a bit. But I have found a new thing, a new gizmo, a new attraction in life. No, it's not your wife, Tom. It's the experience of the vibrations. I love this Hollywood term, getting into it royal!

I have been traveling a bit recently. I have been, shall we say, "haunting" some people. I have been haunting a few astronaut friends, and I have been haunting the Senator Jake Garn. Jake and I were buddies — he called me his "mother hen," I helped him get ready

for his... dammit, he got up and got back. I don't know what I did; I guess that was my one trip and I blew it when I gave it to him — I don't know.

Now, the reason I've been doing this is not to drive people crazy, although that's not far from true for some people. But, we're all working very hard to get people open and receptive to what's going on here. I have to resist the temptation to get really nasty — too violent, I guess, with my thoughts and my words.

But Tom and Sam know me and have seen me in all my glory. But I can share this with Vickie — and I mean this truly — that I am so goddamn communicative that it's not even funny. And I have also given a lot of evidential information, and I will continue to — I kind of enjoy it, I really enjoy it.

I'm not as... as the Commander seems to be getting on it. I like the challenge of being able to key in to things that have happened to me recently and to be able to try to transmit them. Anyway, Jeanne likes me. She's willing to let me come in, and her husband's a pretty good guy to let his wife wander off and have all these strange people communicating.

I have a vision, one I'd like to share with you — whomever is watching us today. And that vision is that someday I'll be on the Merv Griffin Show or the Phil Donahue Show. It'll be the ultimate in humility because you won't see me. It'll be even more progressive for me because I'll be channeling through a woman. (pause) Maybe it won't come about, but the point is that it's that important to me and I know it is to people that have experienced it.

We don't see a lot of the future, because they're encouraging us to shape our own future — teaching us how to do it. But they're encouraging us to do it with a sense of spirit, God, and letting go and stop manipulating things and let them flow and have these intuitive processes going on.

Well that's something very new for Mike Smith. Although, I guess on looking back on it, I flew my airplane that way. I mean I had all the skills. Don't you find that, Tom, that there comes a point in time when the "learned stuff" is just background and it's the intuitive gut feeling you've got when you're holding on to those controls?

Tom:

...

Mike:

I guess that's what makes the difference between pilots who survive and pilots that go down, although I can't say much for that 'cause we went down, didn't we... But we didn't even run the damn thing! ...flying it. The computers — HAL was, the Supremeness — did it then. I was always fascinated by that. I loved ... movies.

I loved "2001" whatever it was, "Odyssey." Gave me chills. (softly) I never said that to anybody, but it really got me going. (louder) Anyway, I would really like to meet with Senator Garn. I put this as a challenge to you, because you folks can do the... Now, dear old Jake is very conservative in his views of "spirit." And I've been with him enough to know that it would really be stretching his concepts to include this in it!

But I also feel that Jake has it in him that, given some time and some evidence, he'd be willing to look at it. And I also feel that because I really like to give evidential information, I could give him information directly to him about the training (it may not be as technical, simply because I have to talk through Jeanne), but I could give him enough of it that he'd know it was me. No way in hell she's gonna know that he's... what does she know about the Space Lab!

Now, I'm speaking for myself — Jeanne's not saying anything about this. We've talked this over quite a bit, and I have to say that Jeanne's consciousness has done more to get me to this point than I have. In other words, she, out of her body at night, is harping on me, "Come on Michael, let's go talk to somebody!" And I'm going, "Shit, man, I don't want to blow it for you." She says, "Look, it's now or never! We gotta do this. You've been talking for a year, now let's do some activity here and show I'm real shaky about political ideas and the whole organization of this man. I enjoyed as hell being with Jake! ... (recording or camera interruption) it!" (sighs)

So, if you feel so inclined, if you want more tape, if you want to do it this way, let us know. I'm willing. Do what I can for you guys. I'll have to admit,

I enjoyed Senator Garn! I enjoyed the hell out of him — he's a wonderful, wonderful guy! But I saw him as a breath of fresh air, an oasis in the rest of the political arena. I'm sorry that I come across that way, but that's just the way I feel. You'll know it's me — if I said anything else you'd know it wasn't Mike! I guess why I didn't like it is because I felt like everybody sold their asses out. And that's probably not a fair judgment, but that's the way I felt. I haven't worked through that one.

Anyway, if you guys wonder what to do with this, we've put our thoughts out, you do what you feel is appropriate, but we want you to know how we feel. We want you to know what directions we want to go in, what... for each one of us, as much as we can.

One more request. And that is that we deal with politicians first in terms of Jake. But I really would like to get in contact with my wife Jane. Jane and I... (pause) share a mutual fantasy. When we were first married we had some friends that had trouble. One of the people got very, very ill and didn't make it and died. That really shook us — we were young kids.

And when he died, Jane said to me, "You really believe where you'll go afterwards? What'll you do if you died too — what if you don't come back?" I said, "Man, I'll tap on your shoulder. I won't need you babe, I won't need you." I felt like I've been tapping on her shoulder for a long time! But it's different now. She's lived a lot longer — she has

three kids. And she's been in the public eye — I'll do that to anybody. Janie, I'm tapping on your shoulder.

Judy:

Hi, this is J.R. I can't tell you how much I love these people I'm with, physically and spiritually. I can't tell you how much I've learned about love. Well, I could, but I can't do it today. I haven't given quite as much evidential information through Jeanne, but I have given some through a friend of mine in California named Jennet. And she's working really nicely with me now — I'm really pleased with her.

She can understand more of me actually than Jeanne can because I was more oriented towards the field of science than working on this level — having those kind of experiences. I was not geared towards having emotional experiences and the psychological ones. But Jennet and I have a good common ground.

But I'll always have a first love in my heart for Jeanne and Tom and Sam. They were our "midwives" or "mid-husbands" or doctors or what-have-you. They birthed us into a new realm, and there's a special bond for a coach like that.

The first night I came through I was extremely distressed and disoriented and didn't really know what had happened to me. It was like only a part of me was really functioning, until they explained to me that the "kitty was up" and that I did not need my body any longer.

But, this (is) a real challenge; the world is physical. The world was this body, the body I had. And to see myself without it anymore was a real challenge. I cried out for my mother. I still cry for my mother, because she cries for me. But I'm OK, just fine. I cried out for not having any children, but then Tom so appropriately stated that (it) would have (been) much harder for me.

But now, I have a different message, and that is that I'm communicating and I'm working and I'm learning and I'm growing. And I will continue to do so, and I will continue to do so in any way, shape, or form that's appropriate. I'm really committed to working with Jennet, but I also have high hopes for Tom, because Tom is a medium himself — he's just committed to other things at this point in time. But I'm kind of holding out for him too, because he has a greater sense of science than Jennet does. They're different... they're different structures.

So Ron and I have been working a lot to facilitate our own abilities to communicate and to grow and understand how to translate the experiences we have on the other side. True, it's hard to do without the language being very creative... English is really a bore for this kind of thing.

I still miss ice cream; I love ice cream, gourmet wonderful ice cream. I've been playing the piano, but I play music in a whole different way over here. And talk about ethereal choirs, I can be surrounded by them any time I want! ... And I go haunt my brother a lot, and I know he feels me, but he doesn't quite know what to do with me. He's been programmed a lot against me — funny world of Hollywood and psychics and yet he still has the feeling inside himself that I'm around and he respects that and I appreciate that. I don't know how I feel yet about sitting in front of him and talking with him... I don't feel quite that stable, simply because a lot of me I don't want to remember.

I don't feel my life is all that worthwhile, looking back on it. People would really say no, that's not true. But it was my life, and perhaps it was wonderful for me while I was in it... I was very appearance oriented, very physically demonstrable. But intuitively, spiritually, I didn't really pay that much attention to that. I mean I was nice to people, but I didn't think about the vast beyond, I didn't think about my life in terms of social contributions. I thought of myself in terms of scientific contributions. But I realize now I cannot isolate those two, that I cannot make a distinction between one or the other. Science is social, social is science — all part of the total.

I think that is probably one reason why we have such imbalances. I feel that perhaps we'd have a lot better discoveries and scientific results if the scientists were not educated to be so closed and focused. But there are scientists who are in tune with it... They're all schooled in how and what to think and how to put things together. This is what you do to get from point A to point B to point C. It's a total ingraining of mediocrity. And it's not even mediocre — it's worse than that.

And yet we spend thousands and millions and billions of dollars to support the field of science which is riddled with filth and degradation. And if you think our political system is bad, we have only to look to the political system of the science foundations. I mean, those are a mess. I'm not saying that certain people don't get credit for good things... once in a while good things happen to good people. But there are a lot of people... and I had professors and I know Ron did, who should never have been where they were. They had that kind of influence over young peoples' lives.

So I'm getting into the education part of it too, I think, in terms of what I can do. I'm thinking already of what I can do when I come back, because I'm going to come back. I'm not quite sure when or how yet, but I know I'm coming back. And I want to have the balance this time that I didn't have before. I want to have the perception of myself spiritually and metaphysically and emotionally. Not that I wasn't a strong cookie... I was strong. I wouldn't have been in the NASA program if I wasn't strong. But I also realized that when I was handling that arm on my previous shuttle flights (that I brought great) will with me. And that all of us were being touched in our own way as we dared to break the field of gravity which held us to this plane.

You know, as we talked among ourselves, there's so many different reactions. Most of the astronauts were very closed-lipped about what they really experienced. But I can remember one time talking with one of the astronauts who had occasion to go the moon. In privacy he said, "Judy, make of the experience what you will, but also allow it

to be an experience that you have no program for. Just flow with it." He said a lot of people, that when they hear what happened to you up there, that no matter who and what you are, it changes your life, more than just in the obvious ways. Do with it what you will, but don't lose it. Pretty profound thought, something I heard, that I worked to understand, and I felt a certain amount of it when I was up previously. But the real meaning didn't hit me until I got to be on the other side.

You know, Gus Grissom has been tremendously influential in our nurturing and growing. And as I understand it Gus has had a lot of years of frustration, so he's giving it everything he has now to help us. Because he tells me that when he first went over, the trauma of his death was really something — the fire, the burning... And the three of them clung together like little scared rabbits, waiting for something to happen after they left their physical bodies. And they were taken, too, and guided, and brought to a place similar to what had happened for us — kind of a holding pattern where they're allowed to discriminate their feelings and thoughts and what had happened to them and to assimilate something of what was going on.

And then, after a little while, they were taken to some people and asked to communicate the same way we did. But Gus said the channel was good, very good, but the dedication wasn't there. And this is Gus's perception and judgment, and maybe it wasn't supposed to be any more than it was. But he still wishes to God those things would come out, somehow, somewhere, that they would release them. And maybe with us they can release those and have the confidence to release what they didn't before.

Gus appeared several times to several different members on the shuttle — not the Challenger, but other ones. Ellison recorded one vision of it. But there were a couple of others who saw him as well but have not said anything. Maybe now they will come forth. And maybe now this whole experience will prove to that part of the Pentagon that's been experimenting with this that this is the ultimate proof of this existence. That has a lot more ramifications than they're willing to deal with. They too would like to separate church and state but really don't know how to in terms of psychic phenomena. That's another level.

There's a couple of others who wish to talk, and I can't take the whole time. ... But we did want to get as many of us as possible for VPI, as we call it, Voice Print Identification... SPI, Sight Print Identification, now that we have a VCR.

I was a good little Christian Jew. I didn't really follow either, but in my heart I had a sense of respect for the universe. And so as I am living a new life for myself now out of the physical world, I would like to wish for those of you who see this tape, not only a Happy Hanukkah, but a Merry Christmas. Because really they are expressions of the same desire to know and understand why we are here. Thanks loads again, and God bless.

This Mama's on a roll. Hello everybody!

Ron:
This Mama's on a roll... I've been wait'n a long lime to say that! Here's my "Southern boy" accent, but as I say to all these folks, now that I'm free of that "black karma" — somewhat — I can kick ass and be a little freer. We worked hard, do you know that, damn it.

Tom, I know what the hell you're going through. You think it's bad — imagine being a black boy! You never know if they give it to you because you're black or because you're bright! Hopefully it was both! ('Cause I was meek!)

Well hello out there in video land, as Michael so appropriately said. This is Shorty Ronald McDonald. I haven't come through her in a long time. Working on you, Tom. We'll get it! This guy's a brain!

Ron:
Hey now brother, you know, take it for what it's worth. I'm from the South — I see the light. But all these little gremlins that run around — we've been together a long time. Someday, through this young man, I'm gonna go into my karma — not the one I drive down the streets, but my karma! And tell him how far back we've gone, and we've gone a long ways. So I'm willing to wait, which has not been a trait of mine, but I know that I have to persevere — "we shall overcome."

I haven't given a lot of evidential information either, simply because I've been working with a couple of other ladies in the South. And it's been a different experience for me. But my God, there's seven of us, and there's seven days in the week, and if we only got to speak one day a week, that still wouldn't be enough for us crazy egomaniacs — plus the fact that there's no way they could survive all that kind of communication, or is it necessary.

I've been content with some associations I've had, but also I've been learning a great deal, and I've been putting my time slot into a long term plan to deal with Tom and some others. And I've been walking the halls — Hi doggie!

But I've been doing my share of haunting. To be honest, though, I'm not really haunting the halls of NASA right now. I'm doing more scientifically, educationally. I've been enjoying — I've been going through some of the big fine universities, just to see what they're doing these days, 'cause I got really ticked at a couple of my professors early on,

and I wanted to see if they changed things any, not that I thought they had, but I thought I'd like to have the experience.

And some mighty fine things are going on — I'm really pleased to see certain things going on, but then there' a lot of it still. So I'm trying to work it out in my own head how I can be best of service, so first of all I feel communicating is my strength — obviously it's a quality I seem to have 'cause I'm doing it. So I'm working with Tom-Boy over there, who seems to have left the vicinity because the dog got rattled. Make sure he looks at the tape. We've been working a lot at night, being he's stubborn. Like looking at myself!

Tom:
Being stubborn?

Ron:
That's not the word for it! Anyway, I'm very, very, stuck on being communicative, trying to have influences. I'm a very fast learner, and I learn very quickly how best to touch somebody — how best to have some kind of input or direction. And I'm real thankful that I've had some really good teachers that stuck with me and helped me. I frequent my family, all of them. They're wonderful people and they've been working their damndest to keep my memory alive. But not in a negative way — they're doing it to kind of further life and society along, and I appreciate that.

I really want to make some contributions, as Judy said, to science. But the humanity of science! I want to make something... (pause) strong — strongly put into the humanity of science in order to feel that we're going to bring about all areas of consciousness in order to get things moving — not just the spiritual, the psychic or the paranormal or the political. But the educational process — the whole gamut of teaching young people to think, really think and become independent, to go at it against all odds.

Glad you're back Tom. Had a couple of things to say to you before you left.

I was just saying to whomever's listening that I wanted to make contributions scientifically and educationally and help balance things out just like J.R. was talking earlier. I also want to be able to give words to the life out of the physical body. I want to give words to the community that we live in. And I want to give directions as to how to get there — for slobbs like me who normally not live them. I want to give some humanity into the physics of today. And that's why I choose to stick around Tom, and I'm willing to work on it — takes a couple of years, fine! But I think that we can make a good team.

Hey brother, you're all right! If there's anything else profound that I have to say today, it kind of escapes me because, coming through Jeanne again, I realize first of all how far

we've come in the last eleven months or whatever, but also how far we've got to go.

But talk about being a baby, learning how to walk, feed myself and function and graduate from high school, all in ten or eleven months — that's what it's been like for all of us. But fortunately the bull sessions now are much more profound, joyous, and illuminating than what they have been the first couple of months.

I also would like to — Greg's working on this — work with helping the shuttle design change. It's still a love of mine to go into space, even though I realize what we were searching for was a spiritual lift, spiritual space. And we were going up physically trying to do it. But it's still a part of me, and if people are gonna go, at least we can try to influence it positively.

We've been working in Europe a bit — they have a shuttle going, not really much better than our design. I think we'd be better off with Buck Rogers. It's funny because the guy that played him was on our site too, and we talked with him. (unintelligible conversation) ...Hey man, we're having a campfire, want to roast some marshmallows tonight? Yeah, make it all black now! That's about what was happening — it's a miracle it didn't happen before.

I don't care how the hell you guys do it, just do it! Just get it out there! Just get it out! The people who are gonna look at this tape. Just get it out! You want a destiny? You have the potential to make it happen. You have the potential to make this whole thing turn life around. If you won't do it, somebody else will. There's a lot of backup systems — I work with more than one psychic, I'm no fool, ha, ha, no fool! ... Merry Christmas!

Ellison:

(after initial warm-up conversation with Tom and Sam)

They didn't stick me in first like they usually do, but they know I was gonna come in today! See how much we've changed? For those of you who don't know about this procedure, I was always the one that took three hours of tape before I came in, so they would scoot me first and not click the tape until I was in.

And then I'd tell them I couldn't say anything and that would be 45 minutes of telling them that I had nothing to say, and they would tease me because I always managed something. And then Sam picked up that I was really awkward about being in a woman's body with these, ah, pearls here. But I'm relaxed as hell, not nervous at all — not a nervous bone in my body!

I need to say something very profound and special and appropriate for the day. Well, all I can say is how much I love these guys and how much I love what they've done for me and what they're doing for me and how it's helping me and I take it with me wherever I go and I stay around my family a lot. ... It's Christmas time, you know, and I haven't even had anything to drink!

Full of spirit over here, man, it's Beethoven's Fifth all the time! (laughs) Jack Daniels, who's he? Some guy down the street. Seven and seven is us! Seven and seven is us standing in front of a 7-11. (more laughing) All the fun's gone... You know, I did something that was kind of funny, I shouldn't tell you this, but I will — I'm not proud, I wasn't a Marine.

I always wanted to get my wife into one of those Geisha places. (whispers) She would never go. The thought of it would make her blush. I would always tease her about that being her Christmas present. If she had ever said yes I don't know what I would have done — probably blushed myself, but it was kind of a running joke.

So now that I don't have to worry about it, a couple of the guys and I went into a couple of the places down on the strip in Hollywood. We went in to different kinds of places. We went in to the male nude dancer crap and the female nude dancer stuff and then we went into the movies. I didn't even watch what was on the screen or on the stage. What I watched — let's not get nasty, Tom!

What I watched was the energies coming off these individuals that were frequenting this place. That's the sleazy part of Ellison, and I cannot run for political office now, because I have admitted to my lustful states! (laughs)

But it really was a study in energies, because we were learning about differences between the energies that are in this house most of the time and in other places — where people are aware of themselves versus people who are kind of dark and dank versus people who are totally off the wall.

We even went down to Mexico. Hey man, I tell you! That was fun! But it was all a study in what it looks like to be yourself. So, you guys out there in video land, here we are. Six said it very well, so I don't have to say more! (laughs)

I've come a long way, because when I first came in through Jeanne, it was the most painful thing I'd ever done in my life. But I can come in now and talk to whoever's willing to listen. I can joke — I still have pain but I have a lot of pleasure too. The pleasure of knowing that... (pause) our deaths were only the beginning. The pleasure of knowing that people are going to hear about us.

They're not going to hear about us in the way in which I used to think about. They're going to think about us in terms of endearment. (There's a good plug for Shirley MacLaine!) Jesus Christ we're not. God we are not. Martin Luther King we are not. Krishna we're not. Sai Baba we're not. We're seven individuals who went through a pretty ugly experience. But we're coming out smelling like a rose!

Because, if we can do it, so can everyone else! And if everyone else begins to realize that there is a continuity to life and that we do live, and the Buddhist philosophy and prayers are going to come up, we're satisfied as hell. Whether a person is a practicing Buddhist or a practicing Christian or a practicing atheist, the one thread of truth that runs through everyone is that of God. ...interpretation, but when we are willing to learn

and when we are willing to let go in terms of our own personal BS, the further along we can come as individuals, the more we can help others.

I have a goal right now that is very strong and predominant. I want to be a good spirit guide. And I've been going with several teachers recently to help people make their transition. And I do it because I had so much good help, and I just have to turn around and do it for others as it was done for me. Nothing's so gratifying in life over here than to take someone in pain who has a body that has to die because it's full of cancer, and help them leave their body and see the joy of freedom on their faces as they meet their friends and loved ones on the other side.

I never watched a baby being born physically... (pause) so I don't know the concerns... The people that come over out of their bodies don't cry like a baby does. It's a wonderful experience. Whatever I can do to help this along, I'm committed to it. And whatever you need of me, if I can give it I will. I can't promise you that I will give you everything you need but I sure will try. Aloha!

(Break)

Greg:

Someone said they're saving the best 'till last! Hi, this is Gregory Jarvis — kind of a nice philosophy. Oh, I love it, love it! But she sprayed it, dammit — I wish she wouldn't spray her hair; I just love to feel her hair! Feels so good! I'm doin' the things I couldn't do when I was in a physical body. She's gonna hate me — I came in last so I could ruin her hairdo. I get off on it, man — it's a part of my lifestyle now — I really love the hair. I love the lady, too!

Hello... (some chit-chat about how much time is left on the tape)...

I have a lot to say, actually. First of all, I'm real ticked at being bumped twice before... so I had to blow up with these fools I been living with for the last ten months — and I mean that in jest. I guess I didn't follow my karmic path very well, 'cause here I had to get pushed and shoved around until I got in the right place and then I never got where I wanted to be. But all seriousness aside, folks, here I am.

I haven't communicated a lot, but I sure have said some loud things when I came through. I mean the statement about the tapes and how people got sick listening to them so they just conveniently lost them somewhere or put them into the fire can or whatever. I made the statement about lovely, beloved President Reagan planting people in NASA to influence it to military ends.

I was outspoken to a degree when I was in a physical body, but I was not nearly as blatant with it as I've become over here. I guess now I don't worry about who my friends are — I know who they are. I don't worry about who my enemies are because I'm already dead! Except that I'm really alive now — alive because I'm not bound by the platitudes and expectations of the physical world. I'm not bound to behave in a certain manner or pattern — I'm free to be what I want to be, and I'm still choosing what that is

— haven't made up my full and complete mind yet.

It's really hard for me to go public. I didn't speak in the public eye until just recently, but I enjoyed it so much, I realized I could handle it. I am very fond of this lady, and I don't want to do anything to hurt her or embarrass her. And I felt confident in transmitting certain information only in the privacy of her home where I knew I was safe.

But I ventured out once and I think I'll do it again, but I'm not as forward in that commitment as some of the others. Real good group, very diverse, very individualistic, and we've been together many times before, I'm sure.

I have several goals. I have some friends that I mentioned very early that were very peripherally interested in things psychological. They're still very peripherally interested, and at first I felt they were really interested because that was my experience, right? But then I got over on this side and I experienced Jeanne and Tom and Sam and others and I realized their periphery (laughs) was way out to lunch! But I have discovered a few family members — distant relatives, kind of, that are interested in me and want to know where I am. And I've had a few good experiences just being with them.

And as they'd look at a picture of me or read something or something would come to them in honor of me and they'd read it over, they would have fond feelings, and I would capitalize on those fond feelings and (pause) send some more and come close.

Anyway, they were real responsive to me (or as much as I could expect). This is a goal of mine... these people I knew, people I worked with... I find it very frustrating with people I worked with, very pragmatic, very closed. Actually, I'm a little embarrassed to say I was an engineer after experiencing some of these people. But then I just feel Jeanne's hair and I know it's all worthwhile!

I have another goal. And that is to do some "shit searching" (pardon the expression!). I'm not trying to be vindictive or mean, but I would like to be able to pull some things out of the hat to prove that I'm really over here and to prove that there are some things that need to be corrected, and then — I'm not gonna leave it there — I want to be able to give some ideas of how to correct it.

I don't want to just expose the dirt, I want to get the dust cloth and clean it all off! I'm not one of those who wants to uncover the roots of the plant and then leave it bare and to die — although sometimes that wouldn't be a bad idea. But I'm willing to commit myself to follow-up time; that's what I'm saying.

(dog barks) I have another goal. And that is to shoot the dog! (laughs) This dog and I go back a long way! This dog knows me — it doesn't bark for anybody else like it barks for me. There's a couple of times when I've jumped out of her skin so strong I was scattered worse than when I died! But I'm getting better at it now — I'm feelin' a lot more comfortable. But I'll tell ya, dog meat wouldn't be a bad idea, Sam! (laughs) I know it would kill the kids. The kids are important to me — I love these children, love these

children.

And I work quite frequently with the little one that's in first grade, her name is K.L., she's real quiet, she reminds me of myself. She has hair too, but she reminds me of me because she's very quiet, but she's very thoughtful and perceptive, and she's having some light experiences that I don't think Jeanne really knows about. But she's a hungry child. She's hungry to know who she is and how those needs get filled up. I'm always at her bedside every night, and I take her hand as she comes out of her body and I walk with her. There's a real bond between her and me...I don't know where we got it, but it's real strong. She's my little charge, I guess. In fact, Sam, tell her mom and dad to get her something electronic for Christmas — some kind of wizard package for her to do her mind on. I don't think they've thought about it — I have a few things I had in mind but I'd like to keep it simple, that she can put together with Tom. You know, it would be really important for her to do something with her daddy. Little personal information there.

So I like working with the people in this house. I don't go out too much from here except to do work. I think that I live here more than any of the others, except maybe Christa from time to time. Mike kind of removes himself because he fills the house up so much that there's not much room for anybody else. But we've all come a long way. It's too bad that this wasn't video recorded when it first happened to see the transition, but you can hear it in our voices from the tapes. But, again, Senator and Scott, I'll do anything I can to help bring about the change.

I have left my personal life pretty well alone. And I have reasons for doing that that I really don't want to have on tape. I would tell you off the record without a tape recorder running, but they're personal and private reasons.

I've spent a lot of time in the libraries over here understanding what it is all about, what we're doing, where we are, why it is the way it is, and there was a time period in there that I think I OD'd. I put myself into a position of wanting to know too much too quickly and I couldn't absorb it all, and I really was emotionally struggling — yes, we do struggle emotionally over here, that hasn't left. I still struggle from time to time. But I'm really exhilarated because I feel like I've found a home. And yet, I know I'm not going to stay in this house forever, but I'm learning and working... (pause) and giving.

And I'm very guided — there's a lot of wonderful spirit beings with us who help us. I had a very traumatic experience when the plane from Mexico went into the mountains. We were real cocky and thought we could handle a new experience, and that in two months' time we had all the answers for this new life. So they took us to wait for this plane to go into the side of the mountain.

And all I did was swear when I came through Jeanne the next day or two. 'Cause it was harder for me in some respects to go through that experience a second time than go through the one initially at first, because initially at first I was amnesiac, but the second one I knew damn well what was going on. Boy, we didn't ask to do that again! You get what you ask for over here!

But I want to make contributions to people I know in terms of verifying their sense of my presence, but I also want to learn and then eventually share more of that understanding. I want to dig — I like to dig for information. But I also want to enjoy life and kick back — took a lot of that workaholicism with me at first, and I think that's why I overloaded. But then I realized the error of my ways and that my consciousness was going to have to change shape, and then I began to relax and I am relaxing.

I'd like to get this woman to relax more, but I can't do all of her laundry for her. Just to cruise, and I'm enjoying it tremendously. And every once in a while I have to come in and play with her hair — it feels so good.

But now that I'm comfortable and now that I'm cruising more, I'm not so frightened of speaking in front of other people because I feel more in touch with myself than I did before — when I worked before I hid myself, didn't want to face me. Now I'm facing me and I feel more comfortable and secure, and I will be here as long I need to be. But I'm working other places and I'm doing other things. I have my job. I have my job in this town... I work with... of consciousness, and I work to protect and to balance and to watch it.

It's a big job for me and I thoroughly enjoy it! I thoroughly enjoy it! I can't wait until these guys move into this new house... It's not far from here and they're gonna move into it no matter what Tom says. A lot of things are gonna go on in that house and a lot of people are gonna come and visit, a lot of important people. And if all we can do is spread that love and that sense of presence in our talks and communications and contacts... I don't want to think about saving the world, but I make a commitment to saving myself and then I can touch other people.

We're never prophets in our own homes. Like several of us have looked back — I won't be specific — we've looked back on our spouses and thought, gee I don't know if I really would do that one again. And I know that's harsh, but we've changed so much and we see the world so differently. And they say the same thing of us, I'm sure. But we don't feel the need to sit around them as much because our attachment to them was for different reasons. We also love our families and we don't want to see them in pain. But we also know they have the freedom of choice to be different just as we do. And we can't make those choices for them — they've got to do it for themselves — but they're not gonna stop our work.

They're individuals and they're responsible for themselves and we're responsible for ourselves and we do our part and they do theirs and everybody does their own thing and we can't worry about how it's going to affect someone else, because then we've forgotten the real sense of destiny and duty to God that brought us here in the first place. And God is my boss here.

I don't want to ask you guys to have to walk a mile in my shoes to understand what it must be like, but if you can, bring yourself to that perception of what it would be like to leave everything you worshipped to find out that what you worshipped didn't even exist on this side of life. Then tell me about what's it like, and tell me what your transitions are

like and tell me what your head's like and tell me where your priorities are. Brother, it happened to me — I'm speaking firsthand experience.

Thank you folks for being interested, for being committed and for listening, for weighing the decisions yourself for what's going on. And if you feel us breathing down your necks, you're right! (laughs) You're right! But not because we want to bug you and turn you away from anything. We enjoy the friendship, we enjoy the consciousness.
